v. Miscellaneous ... Types of disability claims:

- ** Original claim—file your first claim for disability compensation
- ** Increased claim—file a claim for more compensation for a disability that we've already determined to be service connected and that's gotten worse
- ** New claim—file a claim for added benefits or other benefit requests related to an existing service-connected disability
- ** Secondary service-connected claim—file a claim for a new disability that's linked to a service-connected disability you already have
- ** Special claim—file a claim for special needs linked to your service-connected disability

** Supplemental Claim—provide new evidence to support a disability claim that was denied

Eligibility for Veterans Pension

The Veterans Pension program provides monthly payments to wartime Veterans who meet certain age or disability requirements, and who have income and net worth within certain limits.

Example:

If a veteran was married and living on a \$1500 a month social security check with no other income assets at all it looks like this program would put another \$306 a month in his pocket ... MAPR amount of \$21,674 - SS amount of \$18,000 = \$3,674 ... or \$306 a month.

 - i. Representative Payee for your social security benefits in case of incapacitation:

Log into your SSA account to nominate up to three people to be your representative payee.

"A representative payee is a person or an organization. We appoint a payee to receive the Social Security or SSI benefits for anyone who can't manage or direct the management of his or her benefits. A payee's main duties are to use the benefits to pay for the current and future needs of the beneficiary, and properly save any benefits not needed to meet current needs. A payee must also keep records of expenses. When we request a report, a payee must provide an accounting to us of how he or she used or saved the benefits."
