


2025 Membership Year Renewal

It is the time of year where we begin our efforts to get all of our members renewed for the 2025 membership year. As usual there are several ways to renew your membership. The dues for the 2025 membership year are unchanged despite National raising their dues by \$5.00.

1. One of the easiest ways is to renew at the post or any Post Officer. Just provide the \$50.00 or \$1,500 dues and we will take care of it for you.
